Police Report, Chief Terry Sivert

Chief Sivert reports 5313 miles patrolled, no maintenance on vehicles. Fourteen traffic citations written. 112 calls answered, 15 motorists assisted with lockouts, 12 arrest (2 violation of probation, 1 driving suspended, 3 drunk in public, 1 felony eluding, 1 obstruction of justice, 1 resisting arrest, 3 capias). Fines Assessed/Collected: \$1095.00 and Paid Fines \$378.67. JPD assisted County on various calls. Helped citizens in obtaining warrants and orders from magistrate. Assisted fire and rescue with calls. Provided routine escorts IGA, Shubert's and Lee Food Mart. Assisted Sheriff's Office with funeral escorts in town.

Dustin Lane has resigned his position as School Resource Officer at Jonesville Middle School.

Rebecca Hines made the motion to advertise for a School Resource Officer; seconded by Bobby Slusher. All in favor, motion carries. This contains reducing the amount the town contributes to \$5,000.

Town Superintendent Report, Jimmy Cluesman

Mr. Cluesman reports 7 disconnect, 5 warnings, 4 reconnects. Fixed several leaks, fixed sewer stop up on Hill Street, ordered tarps to cover pipe, new maintenance truck will be here Thursday. Mr. Cluesman requested a wooden bed for the gray truck so that it may be used in the park. All the Council was in agreement to place a wooden bed on the gray maintenance truck.

Darian Musick, Crossroads Engineering spoke stating that the larger meters have been ordered and will be replaced soon.

Water Plant Supervisor Report, Brian Bush

Mr. Bush reports 11.2 million gallons of water produced, 6.5 million sold and 4 million sold to Woodway. The average pump hours were 19. 43% water loss. Annual report was published in newspaper.
