**Police Report, Chief Terry Sivert**

Chief Sivert reports 3628 miles patrolled, no maintenance on vehicles. Ten traffic citations written. 90 calls answered, 4 motorists assisted with lockouts, 30 arrest (21 Counts of Animal Cruelty, 1 Trespassing, 1 Possession of schedule II substance, 1 Possession of Schedule IV Substance, 1 Assault and Battery, 1 Driving Suspended 4<sup>th</sup> Offense, 4 Counts of Welfare Fraud). Fines Assessed/Collected: \$269.00/\$912.51 JPD assisted County on various calls. Helped citizens in obtaining warrants and orders from magistrate. Assisted fire and rescue with calls. Provided routine escorts IGA, Shubert's and Lee Food Mart. Assisted Sheriff's Office with funeral escorts in town.

JPD will hold a Neighborhood Watch Meeting May 16 at 6:00. August 2, 2016 is National Night Out, this will be Police Community Relationship Builder. Plans are being made with other agencies to hold this event. Chief Sivert will notify the Mayor and Council as more information becomes available.

**Town Superintendent Report, Jimmy Cluesman**

Mr. Cluesman reports 8 warnings, 8 disconnects, 7 reconnects and isewer back up repaired. The starter on the white Ford F-150 had to be replaced and the clutch on the dump truck is still not working correctly, it is to be repaired this week.

**Water Plant Supervisor Report, Brian Bush**

Mr. Bush reports 9.5 million gallons water produced, 5.4 million sold, 2.8 million gallons sold to Woodway Water Authority with a 43% total loss of water and a average pump time of 17 hours. The Annual Water Report will be published in the Powell Valley News Weekender in June.
