Police Report, Chief Terry Sivert

Chief Sivert reports 5665 miles patrolled, no maintenance on vehicles. Eleven traffic citations written. 88 calls answered, 8 motorists assisted with lockouts, 6 arrest (3 Assault & Battery, 2 Drunk in Public, 1

Probation Violation). Fines Assessed/Collected: \$713.00, collected \$1269.20. Chief Sivert and Sgt. Mullins attended Field Training Officer School at the Academy which is required by DCJS. JPD assisted County on various calls. Helped citizens in obtaining warrants and orders from magistrate. Assisted fire and rescue with calls. Provided routine escorts IGA, Shubert's and Lee Food Mart. Assisted Sheriff's Office with funeral escorts in town.

Sgt. Mullins addressed the Council regarding the 10-33 Program by the Department of Defense. This program is excess items from the military that are given to other federal, state, and local agencies for use. Sgt. Mullins has acquired a few things that must be picked up in Pennsylvania. He is asking the Council and Mayor for reimbursement for gas, motel, and meals for he and Chief Sivert to go pick these items up. Brian Huff made the motion to pay for gas, motel, and meals for Sgt. Town Superintendent Report, Jimmy Cluesman

Water Plant Supervisor Report, Brian Bush

Mr. Bush was not present. His report stated 10.3 million gallons water produced 2.7million sold to Woodway, 7.3 million sold to other customers, average hours of pumping time was 18.5. Percentage of loss was not given this month.
