Police Report, Chief Terry Sivert

Training is free and we got a scholarship to pay for his room. JPD assisted County on various calls. Helped citizens in obtaining warrants and orders from magistrate. Assisted fire and rescue with calls. Provided routine escorts IGA, Shubert's and Lee Food Mart. Assisted Sheriff's Office with funeral escorts in town.

Town Superintendent Report, Jimmy Cluesman

Mr. Cluesman reports 8 warnings, 9 disconnect, 5 reconnects. Water problem at Mill Hollow has been resolved . Five thousand feet of pipe was laid with 1000 feet being taken back up and put back on the old system. This 1000 feet of line could be used to relay line across Ronnie Montgomery's property to Collins Road to help increase their pressure. No sewer issues this month. Eleven Miss Utility tickets, read meters, picked up garbage and brush, 4 new tires on dump truck and no sewer issues. Twelve inch line will be hooked up on Saturday; water will be off approximately 5 hours during this.

Water Plant Supervisor Report, Brian Bush

Mr. Bush reports water loss has increased. The initial response to water plant problem was good. Mr. Bush had no further report at this time.
